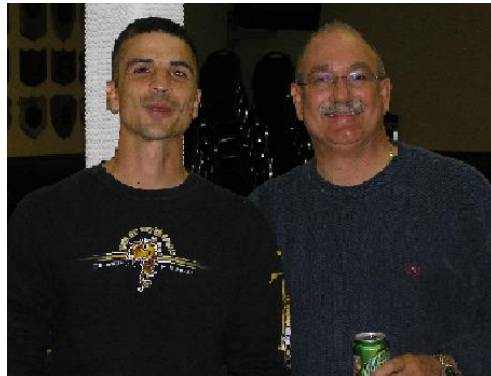

SUBASE recently conducted a trip to the Carl Vinson VA Hospital in Dublin, GA. RPC Jimmy Hill and CMDCM Joe Kunz from SUBASE were the driving force in making this a success as an annual tradition for Kings Bay. Each year, Sailors and Marines from Kings Bay venture to the VA Hospital to

spread some holiday cheer. Chiefs from SUBASE, TTF, NSSC and various boats helped make our veterans staying at the hospital get in to the holiday feel. Whether we made the trip via bus, van, or car, the trip was well worth the time and paid off for all those that we interacted with. Among the personnel from the various local commands included Tom Curtin and Lenny Walk. During their visit they encountered a Vietnam Vet, 1SG Richard Omary, who had endless stories of his 20 year career, which spanned the 1960s and 1970s. He was full of stories that kept all listening personnel entertained. Following Richard's storied

He conducted missions during his career on which he was able to be onboard "Old Diesel Boats."

## Membership for the Kings Bay CPOA

Membership to the Kings Bay CPOA is open to all active and retired E-7 to E-9 personnel in the Kings Bay Area. Regular members consist of active duty Navy Chiefs, while associate membership consists of active E-7 to E-9 personnel in other branches, as well as all E-7 to E-9 retired members. Dues for all shore personnel are \$5 a month or \$50 for the year. Dues for sea going

personnel are \$3 a month or \$30 for the year. If you pay for a year in advance, you receive a complimentary coin. Contact TMC Sam Hall if you need to pay or check the status of your dues. As of December, we have over 200 members in good standing. We are looking to expand those numbers throughout the year. In addition, all Chiefs who made it in Kings Bay for FY07 are paid in

full until September 2007. Lunch each month is free for all members in good standing. If you pay for lunch, you have then you have paid for dues for that month.
